Program Terminology

Guaranteed Tuition Program

Provides financial aid assistance for low-and/or middle-income students often referred to as a promise program by the university.

Guaranteed Tuition Plan

Locks in tuition and mandatory fees from the date of initial enrollment for a period of typically 4 years for new undergraduates (also a "guaranteed price plan" or "fixed rate tuition").

Promise Program Partnerships

Community-driven program featuring agreements with specific community colleges and universities to provide a last-dollar grant that will cover any gap between what a student's state, federal, and institutional financial aid cover and the cost of tuition at a Promise Partner college (Universities that participate in one or more regional promise programs reflect this participation, such as the Dallas County Promise, Texoma Promise).

Regional Promise Programs

Provides transfer opportunities with community college credits earned first.

Offered by Red River Promise, Alamo Promise, and others.

Adjusted Gross Income (AGI)

Some universities refer to Family AGI and others to Household AGI. Contact the college for eligibility and income criteria.

Angelo State University

Blue and Gold Guarantee

The Blue and Gold Guarantee assures that tuition and mandatory fees are covered by gift aid (grants, scholarships, exemptions and/or waivers). Students can continue qualifying for the program for up to 8 semesters (four years) as long as students meet the renewal requirements listed on the website.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- ☐ First-time Freshman or transfer student
- ☐ Admitted and submitted a FAFSA by by May 1
- ☐ Federal Pell Grant eligible and have financial need
- ☐ Family Income \$85,000 or less

President's Promise Scholarship

The President's Promise Scholarship is an institutional scholarship awarded to freshman and transfer students who meet specific criteria.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT

The scholarship covers all tuition not covered by other grants or scholarships. It will meet 100% of the student's tuition costs for up to four years for new freshmen or up to two years for new transfer students.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- ☐ First-time new freshman or first-time new transfer (from a two-year college with an associate degree or earned 45 credit hours)
- ☐ FAFSA on file
- Pell eligible
- May be combined with Honors College or donor-funded scholarships
- ☐ Household AGI \$85,000 or less

- Must enroll and complete 15 semester credit hours at A&M-Commerce during Fall/Spring
- Renewable up to 8 long semesters
- ☐ Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA

Lamar Promise Program

The Lamar Promise Program ensures that sufficient grant and/or scholarship assistance will be provided to cover the full amount of fall and spring in-state tuition and fees for undergraduate Texas residents meeting certain eligibility criteria.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- 1st time Freshman, seeking first undergraduate degree, and new first time in college freshman or transfer
- Admitted by Feb 1

- ☐ Texas Resident who is Federal Pell Grant eligible

- Household Income of \$40,000 or less

Mustangs Guarantee Program

Midwestern State University will offer the Mustangs Guarantee Program to students new to MSU who have not previously received a Baccalaureate degree; students must be Texas residents, Pell Grant eligible, and whose family's combined annual Adjusted Gross Income is \$85,000 or less.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT

The Mustangs Guarantee Program will cover the remaining balance of any tuition and mandatory fees for 12 or more credit hours each semester for up to four academic years (summer terms and non-MSU enrolled hours are not included) that are NOT covered by other grants, scholarships, exemptions, benefits, and/or waiver programs received by the student.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- 1st time Freshman, seeking first under- graduate degree, and new transfer
- □ FAFSA complete by June 1 for Fall, Nov 1 for Spring
- Federal Pell Grant eligible
- Be a dependent student per FAFSA

Texas Promise Facts

Of the 35 general academic public universities in Texas, 34 offer at least one form of guaranteed tuition program.

Family/household income levels served range from \$30,000 to \$130,000, with \$65,000 the median for these programs. Two universities offer a tuition stipend for families earning over \$60,000 and up to \$125,000 or \$130,000. (University of Houston and Texas A&M University, respectively).

Three guaranteed tuition programs serve families with an income of up to \$125,000 (Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi, The University of Texas at Austin, and The University of Texas – Rio Grande Valley).

All of the programs are eligible for freshmen (excluding Texas A&M University – Central Texas, an upper-level campus).

Three programs require Top 25% high school ranking for consideration (Tarleton State University, Texas A&M International University, and The University of Texas at San Antonio). Of these, Texas A&M International University offers minimum test score achievement as a substitute for Top 25% standing. Additionally, Texas A&M University – San Antonio's program is open to Top 10% students and Top 11 - 35% students with a family AGI of \$70,000 or less. And, The University of Texas – Rio Grande Valley requires Top 10% standing or a test score substitute for program eligibility.

Texas Woman's University is less restrictive. They don't have an AGI cap, don't limit to new students, and don't require certain high school rankings.
